SOCIAL CHALLENGES

Position of women in the Family in relation to father, brothers and husband

- Position of women inside of the ethnic community related to participation in the decision-making process
- Low application of inheritance rules dictated by religion and law



Certain customs which exclude women from accessing to land in rural area

POLITICAL CHALLENGES



Lack of a clear land policy integrating women's access to land

Lack of a program dedicated to strengthening women's access to land except for a few actions

Low access of women to land governance institutions

ECONOMIC CHALLENGES

Low involvement of women in economic life, particularly in rural areas

Low financial capacity of women, particularly rural women

The opacity of land market and difficulty of access to land due to the high cost of land, particularly urban land

Poor training of women to become project leaders, particularly in rural areas


Women Land Access Opportunities



PUBLIC POLICIES

- Public program "IKRAM" to empower women and to make gender equity in all public policies
- Sustainable Development Strategy to protect natural resources and to enhance environmental challenges
 - National Land Strategy currently being developed
- Generation Green 2030 strategy to strengthen capacity of rural women and to mobilize 1 Million Ha of land

SOCIAL AND LEGAL REFORMS




LAND PROGRAMS

- Systematic registration programs in rural areas which reenforce land tenure security
- Program of *Melkisation* of collective land in rural areas (66 000 ha) for women beneficiaries
- Program to combat unsanitary housing and housing assistance in urban areas
- Creation of the Center for the inclusion of women in land to encourage women land access
